As a company, we have a zero-tolerance approach to modern slavery and are committed to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business dealings and relationships (see Anti-Slavery and Human Trafficking Policy 2022). Since April 2020, our Health, Safety and Quality panel, consisting of a cross-section of employees from various departments of the company, has focused on developing processes within the company to raise awareness and offer practical solutions to ensuring that our employees as well as sub-contractors are pro-active in tackling the risk of human trafficking and modern day slavery in the construction business. These processes, amongst other social and environmental issues, are presented to all staff at our quarterly town hall meetings, are discussed and employees are asked to act upon these immediately; particularly when engaging or dealing with sub-contractors. The panel will continue to update and amend the processes throughout the year and staff will be notified.
